Fundisa Early Childhood Development Programme

With this programme Kamcare focusses on 32 nursery schools in Refilwe and 30 nursery schools in the Roodeplaat area.

Some of the nursery schools are situated as far as Shoshanguve, Eersterust as well as Mamelodi. Some of the schools are registered and have well equipped nursery schools while the majority operate from small informal houses which serve as homes at night and a small school by day.

Our main focus is the development of the approximate 2000 children who attend these schools.

It is important to Kamcare that the children develop holistically; the Kamcare programme has 4 goals:

- Teacher Training (this is where the sustainability of the programme lies)
- Provision of wholesome mealie meal and vegetables.
- Provision of Educational Crates containing stationery and educational toys
- Upgrading of Nursery Schools

Kamcare has also had the privilege to, together with the University of Pretoria's Educational Department, to equip nursery school teachers with the Read with Meaning programme.

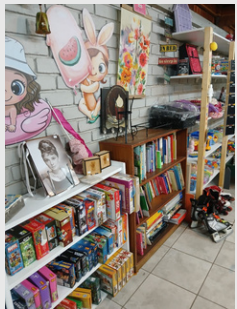


3 Groen Kameelperd
